


Indian Chemical Council

Ray brought together a group of industrialists including Rajmitra B. D. Amin and founded this national association.

What began as a vision, emerging from foresight and aspirations of the founding members, became the Indian Chemical Manufacturers Association (ICMA) and was subsequently rechristened as Indian Chemical Council (ICC). It has become the representative body of chemical industry in India and includes members both Indian companies as well as subsidiaries of multinational companies operating in India.


