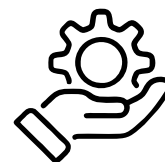
The Only Indian Association to become Full Member of **International Council of Chemical Associations (ICCA)**

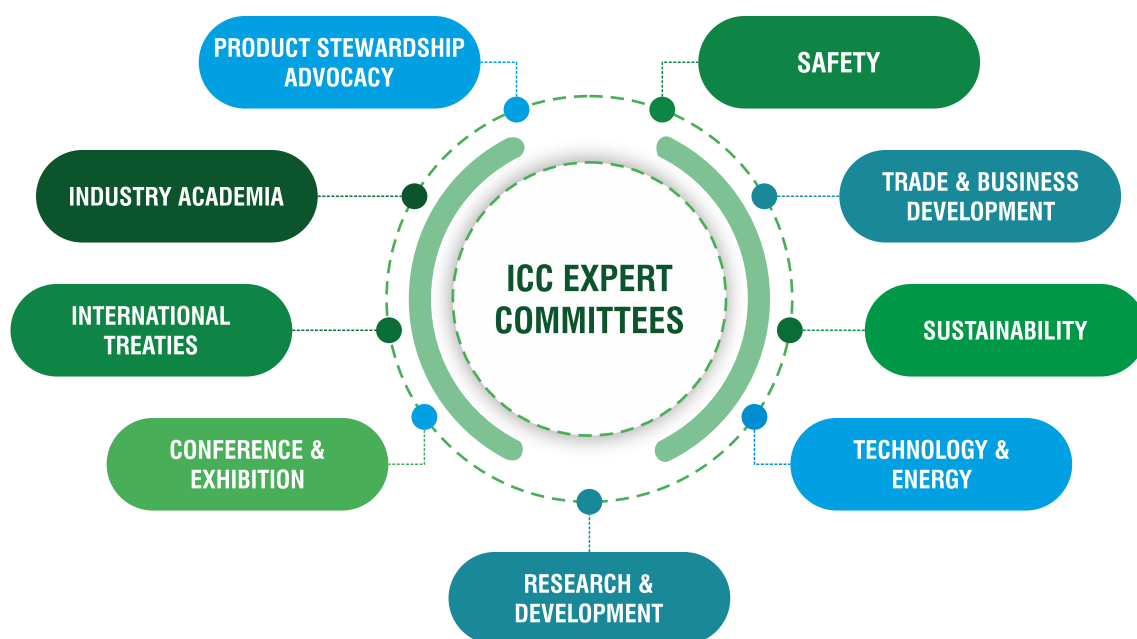

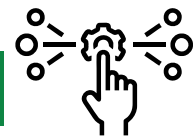

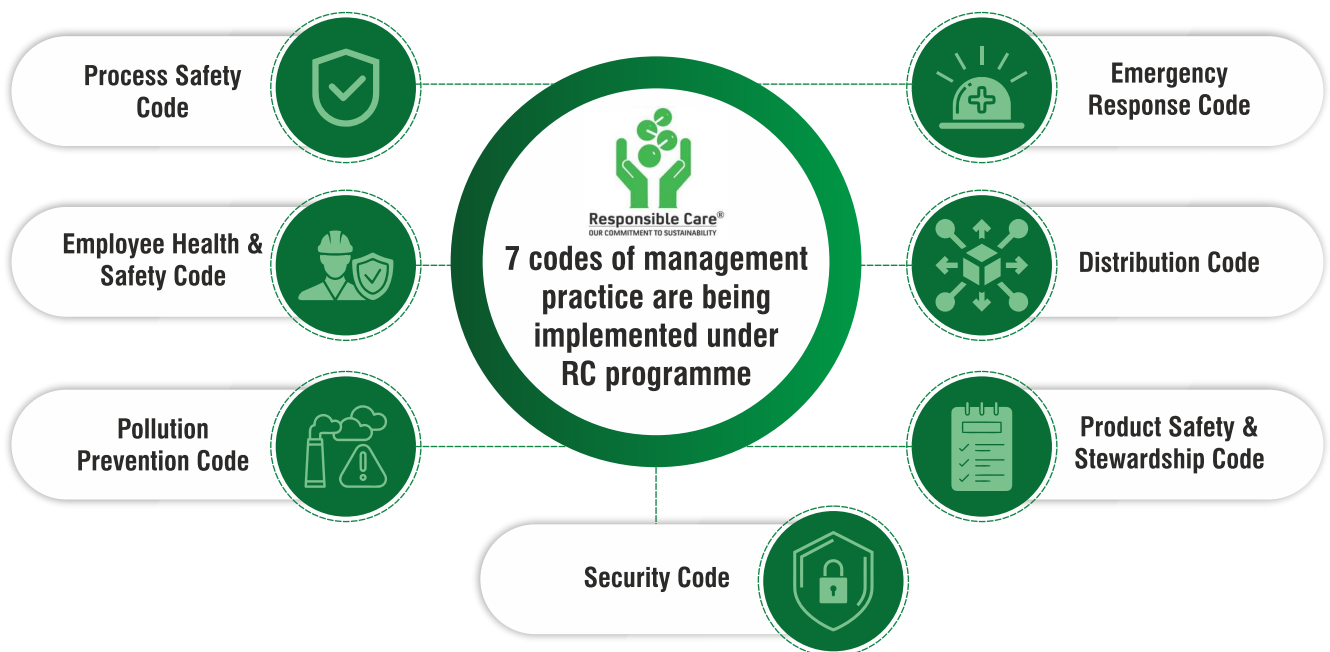


Responsible Care® (RC)



Responsible Care (RC) is the global chemical industry's voluntary initiative to drive continuous improvement in safe chemicals management and achieve excellence in Environmental, Health, Safety and Security (EHS&S) performance

In India, Indian Chemical Council has been the only designated nodal agency by ICCA, for award of RC logo to the industries.



Steps involved in obtaining RC logo





Guiding principles of Responsible Care



- To recognize and respond to community concerns about chemicals and industrial operations
- To develop and produce chemicals that can be manufactured, transported, used and disposed off safely
- To make health, safety and environmental considerations a priority in planning for all existing & new products and processes
- To report promptly to officials, employees, customers and public, information on chemical related health hazards and to recommend protective measures
- To counsel customers on the safe use, transportation and disposal of chemical products
- To operate industries and facilities in a manner that protects the environment, health and safety of employees and public
- To extend knowledge by conducting or supporting research on health, safety and environmental effects of products, processes and waste materials
- To work with others to resolve problems created by past handling and disposal of hazardous substances
- To participate with Government and others in creating responsible laws, regulations and standards to safeguard the community workplace and environment
- To promote principles and practices of Responsible Care by sharing experiences and offering assistance to others, who produce, handle, use, transport or dispose chemicals

- Prioritizes environmental measures to reduce the carbon footprints & water consumption and improve energy efficiency



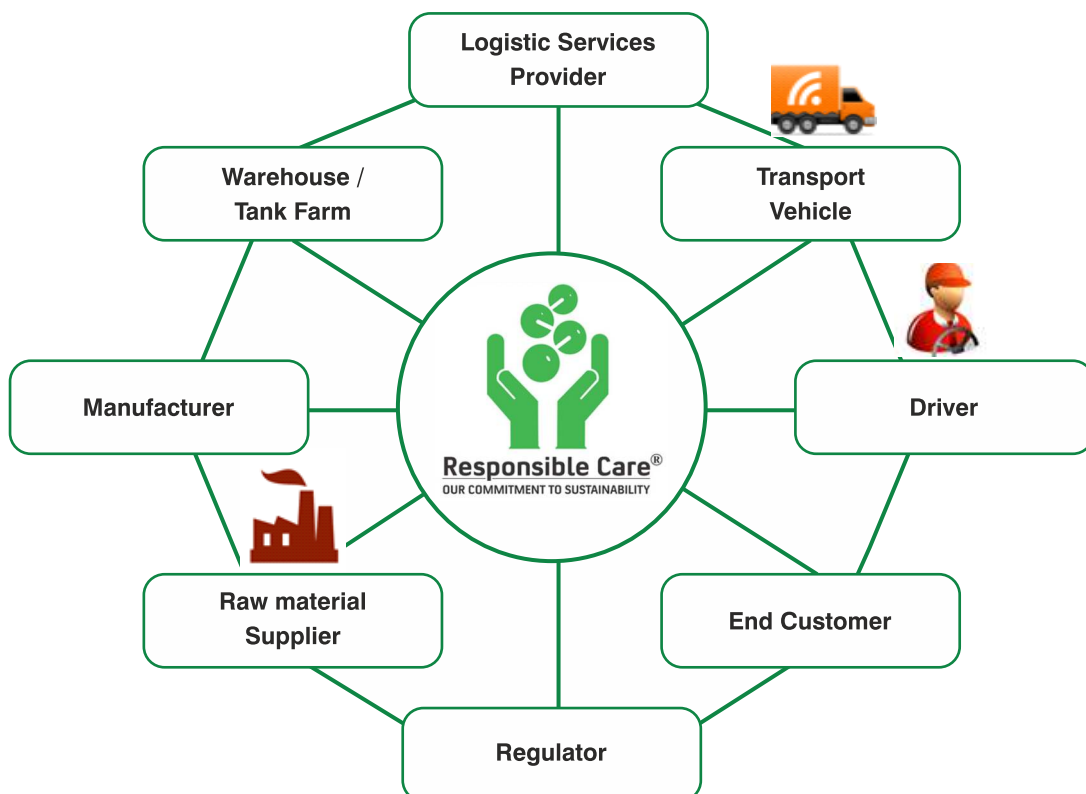


Nicer Globe

- Provide a cost effective and easy to use technology platform to the chemical industry for improvement in Safety and Security standards in Transportation and efficient 24/7 Emergency Response
- Foster mutual cooperation and collaboration within chemical industry
- Provide a network of Quick Response Teams, pan India for efficient and effective handling and management of offsite transport accidents and incidents





Benefits of Nicer Globe for Chemical Company

- Integration of track and trace data from multiple GPS service providers on a single Nicer Globe Platform.
- 24/7 monitoring and early detection and prevention of violations
- 24/7 services of Emergency Response Control Centre to provide online guidance by trained experts in handling and management of transportation incidents and accidents
- 24/7 services of trained Quick response Teams for Level3 support at the incident site for handling and management of transport incidents/accidents
