MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this 04th December 2021 by and between

Department of Environmental Studies, Faculty of Science, The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, Vadodara, Gujarat, India, The FIRST PARTY represented herein by The Registrar (hereinafter referred as 'First Party', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors –in-office, administrators and assigns).

AND

Indian Chemical Council-Gujarat situated at 103, La-Citadel Complex, 30 Nutan Bharat Society, Vadodara-390007, Gujarat, India, the Second Party, and represented herein by its representative, Mr Ravi Kapoor (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS:

FIRST PARTY

First Party is a Department of Faculty of Science at the State Government Higher Educational Institution named the Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda. India's internationally renowned The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda (1949) has blossomed from the Baroda College (1881) which is one of the oldest centers of learning in western India. MSU is the only state University with a residential, unitary character having English as sole medium of instruction with more than 1,200 well-qualified faculty members and more than 1,800 administrative staff to facilitate the learning of more than 45,000 students having cosmopolitan life on campus. The University caters to the fields of Arts, Science, Commerce, Education & Psychology, Medicine, Engineering & Technology, Law, Management, Pharmacy, Performing Arts, Fine Arts, Family & Community Sciences, Social Work and Journalism & Communication.



SECOND PARTY

INDIAN CHEMICAL COUNCIL-GUJARAT

Indian Chemical Council is a more than 80 years old apex national body representing all branches of the Chemical Industry in India. The Indian Chemical Council is dedicated to the growth of the Indian Chemical Industry. It has become the representative body of India's Rs.7083 billion (US \$ 104 billion) chemical industry. Its members include both Indian companies with a global presence as well as subsidiaries of multinationals. **ICC** is well represented by senior executives from a wide range of global and local chemical companies. The executive committee of the **ICC** includes veterans of the chemical industry with vast experience and keen insight into the workings of the chemical industry in India. Their guidance and vision steer **ICC** to further growth and service. Activities of **ICC** include organizing various seminars and events for dissemination of information, safety, health and environment issues relating to the Indian chemical industry. These programmes cover a gamut of topics concerning the issues relevant to the Chemical sector.

The Head office of ICC is situated in Mumbai and the Gujarat chapter office is in Vadodara, Gujarat.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES OUTLINED IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: OBJECTIVES

- First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- The Parties intent to -
 - a. cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the area of Skill Based Training, create Mentor pool, Industrial exposure of the students of First Party, Contribute in Course design to make it more effective for industrial perspectives.
 - b. provide the best possible support to the students by providing internship opportunities, hands-on workshops, dissertation projects, mentorship sessions from the industry experts.
 - c. arrange industry expert's sessions/seminars/lectures for the students.

- d. provide industrial exposure to the students and faculty members of the first party to motivate them for the latest trend of technology in the industry.
- e. provide a single window for the students for all Industry-Academia projects related activities.

CLAUSE 2: DELIVERABLES OF BOTH THE PARTIES

Deliverables by First Party: Department of Environmental Studies, Faculty of Science, The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, shall in good faith provide all requisite support and assistance to Indian Chemical Council-Gujarat to achieve objectives contemplated under this MOU to the letter and spirit; more specifically comply with the following obligations:

- To promote Industrial training in all possible curriculum
- To coordinate for Internship of students in Industries
- To Design Certificate Courses / Syllabus as per MSMEs requirement
- To promote Placement drive with the help of Indian Chemical Council-Gujarat & industries
- To invite experts from various national institutes of repute and Industries in the University for their inputs

Deliverables by Second Party: Indian Chemical Council-Gujarat shall in good faith provide all requisite support and assistance to the Department of Environmental Studies, Faculty of Science, The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda in order to achieve objectives contemplated under this MOU to the letter and spirit; more specifically comply with the following obligations:

- Will coordinate with industries to create a mentor pool
- Engage industry mentors for guiding the students.
- Host Field visits or factory visits for exposure to the students
- Arrange for Brainstorming sessions by Experts or Lecture Series
- Arrange for Industrial training
- Will facilitate internship of 3-6 months to students
- Will help in Research and Dissertation projects to students of the final year of UG and PGAL COURSE
- Will assist in designing Skill upgradation programs for students

- Will support in providing opportunities for project work / case studies etc.
- Will assist in connecting potential Startups / Innovation to interested industries for guidance or strategic collaborations.

CLAUSE 3: ASSIGNMENT

It is understood by the parties herein that this MOU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither Party shall transfer or assign this MOU, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party, without the written consent of the other party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

This Agreement will be valid for 3 years from the date of signing of MOU and it can be extended for a further period of 3 years on mutual written consent of both parties. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. However, termination of the MOU will not in any manner affect the interests of the students/faculty members /scientists/ working professionals from the first party and second party who have been admitted to pursue a program under the MOU.

CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a joint venture or business partnership of any kind between the Parties. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

CLAUSE 6: FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS TOWARDS EACH OTHER

There shall not be any financial obligations on part of first party for executing the scope of work. However, if any expenses are incurred, the parties may mutually

decide as to who should bear the total expenses or in what proportion the expenses be borne depending upon the nature of the collaborative activity.

CLAUSE 7: CONFIDENTIALITY

Confidentiality Each Party acknowledges that, pursuant to this MOU it may have access to certain information concerning the other Party, which is either confidential or proprietary in nature, whether received orally or in writing. All information given by one Party to the other, pursuant to and under this MOU will be deemed to be confidential information no matter whether it is labelled or not as confidential information by the disclosing party. Each Party acknowledges and agrees that all confidential information whether disclosed orally or in writing, is the property of the disclosing party. The Parties agree that the recipient of the confidential information shall neither disclose to any third party nor use for any purpose other than for the purpose of this MOU, without the prior written consent of the disclosing Party.

General: No party shall have the right to contract on behalf of or bind the other party or make any commitment, representation or warranty for or on behalf of the other party.

The MOU does not restrict each Party from collaborating with any other third parties in the areas specified in this MOU.

Each institution will designate a coordinator to coordinate activities related to this MOU and intimate the other Party in writing. Nothing contained herein shall commit either party to perform any specific obligation whatsoever, including but not limited to, research development effort or provide specific educational services, but merely indicates the parties' intention to enter into separate ad-hoc agreements.

In case, if any doubt, questions arise in any part of this MOU, then both the Parties must consult with one another to find a solution.

CLAUSE 8: NOTICES

Any notice or other communication under or in connection with this MOU shall be in writing in the English language and shall be delivered personally or sent by registered post or courier, to the party due to receive the notice or communication at its registered office address set out in this MOU or such other address as either party

may specify by notice in writing to the other. It is expressly understood that notices by email mode are not acceptable to the Department of Environmental Studies, Faculty of Science, MSUB.

CLAUSE 9: NO BENEFITS

No benefit, either in cash or kind, has been provided by any party or any of its respective agents to any officer or employee, or any relative/associate of any officer or employee of the other parties or of any of its associate companies, in order to procure this MOU. Each party further undertakes that it shall not provide any benefit, either in cash or kind, to any such officer/employee/relative/associate as reward or consideration either for retaining this MOU or for any other matter relating to this MOU.

CLAUSE 10: AMENDMENTS

Any Amendment / and or addendum to this MOU shall be in writing and signed by both the Parties hereto and shall only after such execution be deemed to form part of the MOU and have the effect of modifying the MOU to the extent required by such amendment or addenda.

CLAUSE 11: DISPUTE REDRESSAL MECHANISM

For any disputes between the parties, first, both parties should try to resolve it amicably but if at all dispute will be not resolved amicably in that case dispute should be referred to binding Arbitration and the determined in accordance with the provisions of The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

The place of arbitration and the seat of arbitral proceedings shall be Vadodara, India. Any arbitral proceeding begun pursuant to any reference made under this Agreement shall be conducted in English language. The decision of the arbitral tribunal and any award given by the arbitral tribunal shall be final and binding upon the Parties.

The Arbitral Tribunal shall be composed of one sole arbitrator if the Parties so agree. Failing such agreement; the Arbitral Tribunal shall comprise of three arbitrators, out of which one is appointed by each Party within a period of fifteen (15) days so intimated and the third arbitrator shall be selected by the two arbitrators so

appointed within a period of fifteen (15) days of their appointment and where such third arbitrator has not been selected on account of a difference of opinion amongst the arbitrators, the third arbitrator shall be appointed in accordance with the provisions of The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

CLAUSE 12: JURISDICTION

In case of the dispute raised before the court, the jurisdiction shall be at Vadodara, Gujarat State in all the matters.




